Dance Name: 39 Again

Formation: Contra, duple-minor, improper

A1

- (1-4) Mirror image do-si-do with the next in line
- (5-8) Mirror allemande once around with the next in line

A2

- (1-8) Down the hall 2 by 2, 1st couple turn as a couple, 2nd couple turn alone and separate, join on the ends of a line with the 1st couple in the middle of the line, return, hand cast around

B1

- (1-8) Contra corners

B2

- (1-8) 1st couple balance & swing

Notes: The allemande is once around because when the dancers go twice around they tend to go too far down the hall before they turn around. Then they never come back far enough and the line moves down the hall.
