

## The Dawn Dance or Don's Dawn Dance

Dance Name: The Dawn Dance

Formation: Contra, duple-minor, improper

### A1

(1-8) Down the hall four in line, turn alone, return, fold the line

### A2

(1-4) Circle left once around

(5-8) Swing your neighbor

### B1

(1-4) Men do-si-do

(5-8) Women do-si-do

### B2

(1-8) 1st couple balance & swing, end facing down

Notes: The A1 part of this dance was originally like Symmetrical Force, where the 1st couple turns under their own joined hands and the 2nd couple joins hands behind the 1st couple. Then the 2nd couple raises their joined hands so the 1st couple can back under..

This dance was first danced for the 1984 Ann Arbor Dawn Dance where it was well received.
